Indiana Code§ 36-7-4-918.5

A Board of Zoning Appeals shall approve or deny variance from the development standards (such as height, bulk, or area) of the zoning ordinance only if (1) The approval will not be injurious to the public health, safety, moral and general welfare of the community; (2) The use and value of the area adjacent to the property will not affected in a substantially adverse manner; and (3) The strict application of the zoning will result in practical difficulties in the use of the property.

ORDINANCE AUTHORITY: Georgetown Zoning Ordinance Regulations

The variance petition shall be approved if the findings of fact are made consistent with the requirements of this Ordinance and the Indiana State Code standards as follows: (I) approval will not be injurious to the public health, safety, moral and general welfare of the community; (2) the use and value of the area adjacent to the property included in the variance will not affected in a substantially adverse manner; involved; (3) the strict application of the terms of the zoning will result in practical difficulties in the use of the property; and (4) any structure that is near an airstrip and regulated under Indiana Code 8-21-10 must meet the requirements set forth in Indiana Code 36-7-7-918.5(b). The petition shall be approved with modification if the Board determines that the required finding of fact may be made if certain conditions are applied to the petition. The Board may make reasonable conditions related to the required findings of fact part of its approval or accept written commitments from the petitioner.
