## AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE G-11-07

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown;

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council placed all police department staff to salaried positions in Ordinance G-11-07 Classifying Patrolman as EXEMPT Employees.

**WHEREAS,** The Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana, after review and consideration, has determined that the role of police patrolmen needs to be moved to hourly pay, Exempt to Non Exempt Employees of the Town of Georgetown and wishes to therefore repeal Ordinance G-11-07.

**Now, therefore, be it ordained** by the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana it is hereby ordered as follows:

- I. The Town of Georgetown hereby repeals Ordinance G-11-07.
- 2. If any part of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, such part shall be deemed severable and the invalidity thereof shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
- 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become and remain in full force and effect and until its repeal by ordinance.
