

ORDINANCE NO. G-13- 07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE G-09-09,
WEED REMOVAL ORDINANCE
FOR
THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA

WHEREAS, by Ordinance G-09-09 the Town of Georgetown established its Weed Removal Ordinance; and


WHEREAS, the Georgetown Town Council wishes to amend Section 91.53 of Ordinance G-09-09 to further limit the height of weeds, grass and rank vegetation within the Town of Georgetown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, THAT ORDINANCE G-09-09 IS AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 91.53. OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS RESPONSIBLE FOR TRIMMING AND REMOVAL.


All property owners, all occupants of single family dwellings, and all occupants of nonresidential properties within the corporate limits of the town shall be required to remove, cut, dispose, and eliminate weeds, grasses and rank vegetation or other uncontrolled plant growth on their property. Weeds, grasses, and rank vegetation shall not exceed 8 inches in height on an area of the property that is 10%, or more, of the unimproved areas of the property.


