Ordinance # G-05-29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §8.3.B OF THE GEORGETOWN ZONING AND SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS, ADDING A NEW SUB-PARAGRAPH SPECIFYING PUBLIC STREET CONSTRUCTION STANDARDS IN AND FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN

WHEREAS, the Town's Engineer, Heritage Engineering, LLC, has determined that there is no standard in place for road construction for the Town; and,

WHEREAS, it is logical that there shall be a standard for road construction to cause the roads to be built to a minimum standard improving their durability, stability and length of service; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown is most interested in preserving the roads within Georgetown to limit the amount of money our citizens must spend to repair roads that are not properly constructed.

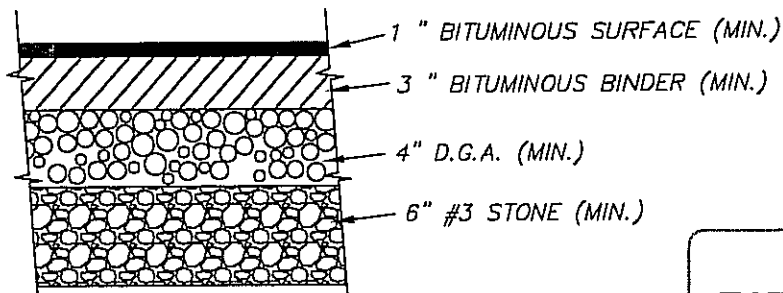
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. Section 8.3.B. of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read:

B. Grading and Improvement Plan. Streets shall be graded and improved and conform to the Town construction standards and specifications and shall be approved as to design and specifications by the Towns designated Engineer, in accordance with the construction plans required to be submitted prior to secondary approval.

1. A cross section of the pavement detail is depicted below. A typical section from top to bottom shall be:

- 1" hot mix asphalt surface
- 3" hot mix asphalt binder
- 4" minimum of dense grade aggregate (DGA)
- 6" minimum of #3 stone

DGA = Dense Grade Aggregate (gravel)

#3 = bigger rocks

#56 = smaller rocks
