Ordinance # G-05- 36

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE WAGES OF EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown is the entity responsible for establishing the compensation of the Town employees pursuant to IC 36-5-3-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown desires to pay the employees of the town of Georgetown a reasonable and competitive wage; and,

WHEREAS, the Town's Utilities employees have saved the Town over \$5,000 in the costs of pumping sewage holding tanks over 2003 and earlier by changes in management policies; and,

WHEREAS, the Town's Utilities employees have replaced five sewer holding tanks, saving the Town approximately \$11,000; and,


WHEREAS, the Town's Utilities employees have stopped using contractors and are doing a great deal of the Town's own construction-related work,; such as building an additional road lane on Kepley Rd, repairing the bridge on Henriott Road, replacing and repairing fire hydrants, renovating the insides of manholes, etc.; and,

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown has determined that the Town's employees shall receive a year end bonus as a token of the Town's appreciation for their hard work and dedication.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED all full-time, regular Town Employees shall receive an annual \$100 year-end bonus at a time to be determined by the Town Clerk-Treasurer during each month of December; ideally at the Annual Employee Recognition Banquet. Regular part-time employees will get a pro-rata share of \$100, based on their weekly work hours. All regular payroll taxes will be withheld from this year-end bonus.


This bonus shall not be paid to temporary and contract employees.


