ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE forbidding the use of the Town Dump of Georgetown without securing a permit and prescribing penalties for any violation.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown:

SECTION I

From and after this date it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to dump refuse, garbage or any material, waste or otherwise, in or about the Town Dump of the Town of Georgetown without first having secured permission from the Board of Town Trustees or the duly appointed agent of such Board in charge of the Town Dump.

SECTION II

Any person, firm or corporation who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

SECTION III

Upon any subsequent or second violation, the penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

The foregoing ordinance was duly passed by majority vote of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown on the 13th day of July, 1966.
