

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE deannexing certain areas of Georgetown, Indiana.
BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of George-

town:

Section I

That all of the territory embraced within the following boundaries, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the present limits of Town of Georgetown; running thence Eastwardly to the west line of the real estate owned by the Archbishop of the Roman Catholic Archdiocese of Indianapolis; running thence South along such West line to the center of State Road 64; thence Westwardly along the center line of State Road 64 to the East line of the Georgetown Drive-in Theater real estate; thence running North to the place of beginning.

be and the same hereby is deannexed from the Town of Georgetown.

Section II

That the above described real estate shall not be within the corporate limits of the Town of Georgetown and that the Ordinance extending the corporate limits of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, enacted on April 4, 1965, is hereby amended so that the above described real estate shall not be included in the territory described in such Ordinance.

Section III

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect upon its passage.
