

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE extending the corporate limits of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown:

Section I

That all of the territory embraced within the following boundaries, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in Section 33 Township 7 South of Range 5 East; beginning at <sup>the northeast corner of</sup> ~~the northeast corner of~~ the present <sup>of</sup> ~~Town of~~ Georgetown; running thence due east to the east line of Jouett N. Reisz's plat and subdivision of Georgianna Acres; running thence due South to the center line of Georgetown Creek in Section 34; thence westwardly following the meanders of Georgetown Creek to the present east boundary line of the Town of Georgetown.

be and the same hereby is annexed to and made a part of the Town of Georgetown.

Section II

That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force after being published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the New Albany Daily Tribune.
