

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE concerning parking of vehicles in the Town of Georgetown, Indiana.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana:

SECTION I

Parking of any vehicle having an over all length of more than Twenty (20) feet is hereby prohibited on any public thoroughfare, street, road or alley within the town limits of Georgetown, Indiana, between the hours of 7:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.

SECTION II

It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to park any vehicle having an over all length of more than Twenty (20) feet on any public thoroughfare, street, road, or alley within the corporate limits of the town of Georgetown, Indiana, between the hours of 7:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M.

SECTION III

Any person, firm, or corporation who violates the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00).

SECTION IV

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect after the second publication of this Ordinance in the New Albany Daily Tribune and Sunday Ledger.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown on the 18 day of December, 1975.
