AN ORDINANCE concerning liquor retail permits in the Town of Georgetown, Indiana.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana:

SECTION I

It is the declared public policy of the Town of Georgetown that sale of alcoholic beverage be prohibited within the Town limits of the Town of Georgetown.

SECTION II

No person, firm or corporation shall operate any establishment within the Town limits of Georgetown wherein any distilled or fermented liquor is sold.

SECTION III

No building permits shall be issued by the Town Clerk of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, for the erection, repair, construction, or alteration of any building that is the situs of any liquor retail permit.

SECTION IV

The Town Clerk of the Town of Georgetown shall certify to the Alcoholic Beverage Commission of the State of Indiana that no establishments shall be permitted within the Town limits of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, where any liquor, either distilled or fermented is sold at retail or wholesale.

SECTION V

The Town Board of the Town of Georgetown shall not consent to the granting of any liquor retail permit to any person, firm or corporation for the sale of liquor, either distilled or fermented,

within the Town limits of the Town of Georgetown.

SECTION VI

By the provisions of this Ordinance, it is hereby enacted and ordained that no liquor permits of any kind shall be permitted within the Town limits of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana.

SECTION VII

If any person, firm or corporation violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, then the President of the Town Board shall immediately cause a Petition to be filed in the Court having jurisdiction for an injunction against the establishment or maintenance of any business within the Town limits of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, wherein any liquor, either distilled or fermented is sold or contemplated to be sold.

SECTION VIII

This Ordinance shall take effect, and shall be in full force and effect upon the date of its passage.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, on the 24 day of February, 1976.
