

ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE extending the corporate limits of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana.

BE IT ORDNATED by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana,

SECTION I

On the _____ day of June, 1974, there was annexed to the Town of Georgetown the 20 acre tract owned by Richard S. Davis and June R. Davis and such 20 acres was incorrectly described.

SECTION II

Therefore such annexation ordinance is hereby amended so that the annexed territory is described as follows:

A part of the Southeast 1/4 of Section 28, Township 2 South, Range 5 East, commencing at the southwest corner of the Southeast 1/4 of said section, thence running north along Canal Lane 657.73 feet, thence east 1328.74 feet, thence south 658.89 feet, thence west 1334.48 feet to the place of beginning. Containing 20 acres.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown, on the 3 day of June, 1976.
