AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF TOWN STREETS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown, Floyd County, Indiana, that this ordinance shall repeal and replace any prior ordinance heretofore passed concerning the regulation of the weight of vehicles using the streets in the Town of Georgetown, Indiana;

SECTION ONE

VEHICLE WEIGHT LIMITATION:

No vehicle using any street in town shall weigh more than Two and One-Half (2.5) tons, which weight shall include both that of the vehicle and its load; excepting therefrom, those vehicles cited below in Section Two (2).

SECTION TWO

EXCEPTIONS TO WEIGHT LIMITATION:

Any school bus, delivery truck or moving van which is being used in its normal mode of operation for the public or private use for which its is designed may exceed Two and One-half (2.5) tons in weight, which weight shall include both that of the vehicle and its load.

SECTION THREE

PENALTY:

Any person, firm, corporation or other entity who operates a vehicle in violation of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$250.00 plus cost of repairing the damaged portion of the street.
