AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND LICENSING
THE USE OF AMUSEMENT MACHINES, PINBALL MACHINES
POOL TABLES AND JUKEBOXES

Section 1. Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown, Floyd County, Indiana, that this Ordinance shall repeal and replace any prior ordinances heretofore passed concerning regulation of amusement machines, pinball machines, pool tables and jukeboxes.

Section 2. Any operator who charges a fee for the use of amusement machines, pinball machines, pool tables and jukeboxes shall be subject to the licensing provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. All operators shall obtain a license from the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown before installing said amusement machines, pinball machines, pool tables and jukeboxes.

(A) The licenses shall be granted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown on application and the payment of an annual fee of \$100.00 per proposed establishment. Said fee shall be due annually on the twelfth day of March beginning March 12, 1980. First year fee shall be due by March 30th after passage of ordinance.

(B) The Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown shall require disclosure of the hours of operation and the fees to be charged of each applicant. It shall be within the Board's authority to regulate the hours of operation of any and all amusement machines referred to in this ordinance.

Section 4. Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation who operates amusement machines, pinball machines, pool tables and jukeboxes, without first obtaining a license shall be deemed in violation of this ordinance and shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$200.00 and not more than \$500.00
