ORDINANCE ALLOWING COMMERCIAL USE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown, Floyd County, Indiana, that this ordinance shall repeal or replace any prior ordinance heretofore passed concerning the commercial use of a parcel of real estate described in this ordinance;

WHEREAS, the owners of a certain tract or real estate located in the Town of Georgetown, Floyd County, Indiana, have applied to the Town Board for a commercial use for said tract;

WHEREAS the Town Board having considered the application for a parcel of real estate described below:

PART OF THE NORTHEAST AND SOUTHEAST QUARTER(1/4) OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 5 EAST, FLOYD COUNTY, INDIANA, CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 3.72 ACRES LOCATED ON STATE ROAD 64. .

The Town Board hereby considers this property to be commercially zoned;

WHEREAS, said applicants, Ronald Glotzbach and Janice Glotzbach, husband and wife, and Robert Payne and Syble Payne, husband and wife, and Charles Meyer have applied to said Board for the verification of commercial use, the Board now adopts the following resolution:
