ORDINANCE ALLOWING COMMERCIAL USE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown,  
Floyd County, Indiana, that this ordinance shall repeal or replace any prior  
ordinance heretofore passed concerning the commercial use of a parcel of  
real estate described in this ordinance;

WHEREAS, the owners of a certain tract of real estate located in the  
Town of Georgetown, Floyd County, Indiana, have applied to the Town Board  
for a commercial use for said tract;

WHEREAS the Town Board having considered the application for a parcel  
of real estate described below:

PART OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 5 EAST, FLOYD COUNTY, IN.,  
PART OF A 3.28 ACRE TRACT RECORDED IN DEED RECORD 170, PAGE 595 OF THE  
FLOYD COUNTY, IN. RECORDS, SUBJECT TO THE RIGHTS OF WAY OF THE SOUTHERN  
ROAD AND STATE ROAD 64.

The Town Board hereby considers this property to be commercially zoned;
