ORDINANCE NUMBER ~~82~~ - G-81-02

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION
AND APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL DEPUTIES
AND PROVIDING FOR CLEANING
ALLOWANCE OF UNIFORMS

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown has used special deputies in the past to adequately protect the health, safety, and well being of the inhabitants of its town, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown now find that it is desirable to establish certain procedures for application appointment and swearing in of said deputies including the limitation of the number of deputies and further providing for a monthly stipend for cleaning allowance in the maintenance of their uniforms; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA:

Section 1. That there is hereby established the office of special deputy to serve under the Town Marshall and by appointment of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown.

Section 2. That any person shall make application for appointment for said position to the Board and upon the Board's finding that they meet the qualifications required, they shall be sworn in and assume their duties.

Section 3. That the number of special deputies shall be limited to five (5).

Section 4. That said special deputies shall serve without remuneration except that they shall be paid Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) per year as a cleaning allowance.

Section 5. All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. The invalidity of each section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given
