AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF BICYCLES AND HORSES ON THE SIDEWALKS OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Board of Trustees of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana,

Section 1: It is declared public policy of the Town of Georgetown, that the sidewalks should be used primarily for pedestrian traffic.

Section 2: No person shall operate a bicycle with a wheel diameter greater than fifteen inches (15") on any sidewalk.

Section 3: No person shall ride, walk or lead a horse or pony on any sidewalk in the Town of Georgetown.

Section 4: Whoever violates any provision of this chapter for which another penalty is not already provided shall be fined not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00).

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force and effect upon the date of its passage.
