ORDINANCE

PREFACE

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown has established refuse and garbage services for its own use and the use of the residents of Georgetown; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown and its residents own, maintain and expend monies on the equipment and containers used for refuse and garbage services; and

WHEREAS, said refuse and garbage services have been used from time to time by non-residents of the Town of Georgetown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Section I. For purposes of this Ordinance "residents" means any person permanently residing in a household within the town limits of Georgetown and any business whose principal office is located within the town limits of Georgetown.

Section II. The town refuse and garbage services are to be provided for and may be used only by the town itself and the residents thereof.

Section III. In no case may a non-resident place, leave, dump, use or dispose of refuse or property in the town limits of the Town of Georgetown for purposes of availing any person, firm or corporation of the use of the town's refuse or garbage services, nor cause to be placed, left or dumped any refuse or property of any non-resident within the town limits for purposes of availing that person, firm or corporation of the use of the town's refuse or garbage services.

Section IV. A violation of this Ordinance shall carry a penalty of a One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) fine for each violation.
