

ORDINANCE G-89-02

AN ORDINANCE FORBIDDING THE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL OF A BUSINESS PERMIT WITHOUT SUFFICIENT OFF-STREET PARKING AND TO REQUIRE ANY BUSINESS TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT OFF-STREET PARKING FOR ITS CUSTOMERS.


BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, that


Section 1. No business or commercial use permit shall be issued or renewed for any business or commercial establishment within the Town limits unless the applicant therefor shall furnish the Town Board proof of sufficient off-street parking for the customers of the business or commercial establishment.


Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any business or commercial establishment to operate without sufficient off-street parking for its customers. Violation of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine up to \$100.00 per occurrence.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication as may be required by the Indiana Code.
