## GEORGETOWN ORDINANCE 1989-04

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PARKING.

Section I. Whereas, the United States Postal Service has requested that residential mail boxes be placed on the south side of High Street in Georgetown, Indiana; and on the north side of Walnut Street in Georgetown, Indiana; in the area from Old State Road 64 to Kepley Pike; and

Whereas, the United States Postal Service has encountered difficulty in delivering mail to such residential mail boxes due to the inaccessibility of the mail boxes;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA:

1. Between the hours of 12:00 noon and 6:00 P.M. (local time), there shall be no parking on the south side of High Street or the north side of Walnut Street in Georgetown, Indiana, said portions of High Street and Walnut Street hereby affected being those areas between Old State Road 64 and Kepley Pike within the town limits of Georgetown, Indiana.

Section II. Any owner or operator of a motor vehicle found to be in violation of this ordinance shall be fined an amount not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each offense, plus court costs incurred.
