

ORDINANCE NO. G-92-05

An Ordinance providing penalties for violations of Ordinance No. G-92-04, the sewer use ordinance of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana

Section 1.

(a) Any person found to be violating any provision of Ordinance No. _____, except Article VI, shall be served by the Town with written notice stating the nature of the violation and providing a reasonable time limit for the satisfactory correction thereof. The offender shall, within the period of time stated in such notice, permanently cease all violations.

(b) Any person who shall continue any violation (other than a violation of Article V, Section 1 of Ordinance No. _____) beyond the time limit provided for in Section 1 (a) shall be fined in an amount not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each violation. Each day in which any such violation shall continue shall be deemed a separate offense.

(c) Any person violating any of the provisions of Ordinance No. _____ shall become liability to the Town for any expense, loss or damage incurred by the Town by reason of such violation.

(d) (i) Any person violating or suspected of violating Article V, Section 1 of Ordinance No. _____, shall be subjected to a penalty of fifty (50) dollars per month (or fraction thereof in which the violation occurs).

(ii) A person may avoid payment of said penalty by consenting to an inspection described in Article IV, Section 9 of Ordinance No. _____, for the purpose of establishing compliance with Article V, Section 1 of Ordinance No. _____.

(iii) A person consenting to such an inspection and found in violation shall be given 90 days to comply with Article V, Section 1 of Ordinance No. _____ without being subject penalty.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed. The invalidity of any section, clause, sentence, or provision of this ordinance shall not affect the validity of any other part of this ordinance which can be given effect without such invalid part or parts.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, recordings, and publications as provided by law.
