

ORDINANCE NO. G-92-19

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TOWN COUNCIL TO
BUDGET AND APPROPRIATE FUNDS FROM THE GENERAL FUND
TO PAY EXPENSES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN THAT:

WHEREAS, The Town Council for the Town of Georgetown desires to promote economic development and tourism in the Town of Georgetown; and

WHEREAS, The Town of Georgetown desires to budget and appropriate funds from the general fund for the purpose of paying expenses in order to promote economic development and tourism in the Town of Georgetown.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED That the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown is hereby authorized to budget and appropriate funds from the general fund of the Town to pay the expenses of or to reimburse the Town officials as the case may be for the expenses incurred in promoting economic development and tourism within the Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED That the expenses incurred in promoting the economic development and tourism within the Town include, but are not necessarily limited to, rental of meeting places, supplies, meals, decorations, memorabilia, awards, donations to local civic groups interested in the economic development of the Town, expenses incurred in interviewing job applicants, expenses incurred in promoting industrial, commercial and residential development, bonuses to employees, expenses incurred in developing relations with other units of government, and any other expenses of a civic or

governmental nature deemed by the Town Council to be necessary for the purpose of promoting economic development and tourism within the Town.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED That this Ordinance shall become effective on the _____ day of _____, 199__.
