

ORDINANCE NO. G-93-8

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. G-92-17 PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF PAID HOLIDAYS AND IN THE AMOUNT OF PAID VACATION TIME FOR THE CLERK/TREASURER AND THE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AND THE GEORGETOWN WATER UTILITY AND SEWER UTILITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNSEL OF GEORGETOWN THAT:

WHEREAS, The Counsel for the Town of Georgetown is the entity responsible for fixing of compensation, benefits, vacation and sick days for the Clerk/Treasurer of the Town, and the Town police officers [hereinafter "officers"] and employees, and also the employees of the Georgetown Water Utility and Georgetown Sewer Utility; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. G-92-17, provides that the employees of the Town of Georgetown and the Water Utility and Sewer Utility have the following holidays off with paid time: New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, Martin Luther King's birthday (to be taken the day after Thanksgiving), Memorial Day, President's Day (one-half taken on Good Friday, one-half on Christmas Eve), any general (national, state or city) election, Christmas Day, the Fourth of July and Labor Day; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. G-92-17 provides that officers and employees of the Town of Georgetown, the Water Utility or Sewer Utility are entitled to one (1) week of paid vacation after one (1) year of consecutive employment, and are entitled to two (2) weeks of paid vacation after two (2) or more consecutive years of employment; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to increase the number of paid

holidays and treatment of paid vacation time for the Clerk/Treasurer and the officers and employees of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana and the Georgetown Utility and Sewer Utility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, That the employees of the Town of Georgetown and the Water Utility and Sewer Utility have the following holidays off with paid time: New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, the day after Thanksgiving Day, Martin Luther King's birthday, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Presidents' Day, any general (national, state or city) election, Christmas Eve day, Christmas Day, the Fourth of July and Labor Day.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That any officer or employee of the Town of Georgetown, the Water Utility or Sewer Utility shall be entitled to three (3) weeks of paid vacation after eight (8) years of consecutive employment.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That any portion of Ordinance No. G-92-17 or any other Ordinance of the Town of Georgetown presently in effect, which conflicts with this Ordinance, shall be null and void and be deemed modified in accordance with the resolutions herein; additionally, any portions of any of the aforementioned Ordinances, or any other ordinance of the Town of Georgetown, presently in effect which do not conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be in full force and effect.

ADOPTED by the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown this the 20TH day of DECEMBER, 1993, and effective as of January 1, 1994.
