

ORDINANCE NO. G94-05

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS FOR TOWN STREETS AND ALLEYWAYS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana that from this day forward, all town-regulated streets, with the exception of Canal Lane, Henriott Road, Kepley Road, and Georgetown-Greenville Road shall have a posted speed limit of 20 miles per hour. Canal Lane, Henriott Road, Kepley Road, and Georgetown-Greenville Road shall have a posted speed limit of 30 miles per hour. All town-regulated alleyways shall have a posted speed limit of 10 miles per hour.

SCHOOL ZONES

All school zones located within the corporate limits of the Town of Georgetown shall have a posted speed limit of 25 miles per hour. School zones within the Town of Georgetown shall be comprised of:


1. the area in the immediate vicinity of Georgetown Elementary School on State Road 64
2. the intersection of Kepley Road and High Street

PENALTY


Whoever violates any provision of this ordinance shall be subject to any penalty levied by Floyd County Court.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage by the Georgetown Town Council and shall repeal Section Nine of Ordinance No. G78-04.







