

ORDINANCE NO. G-95-05

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY/FAIR HOUSING ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, it is the public policy of the Town council of Georgetown, Indiana and of the State of Indiana to provide all of its citizens equal opportunity for education, employment, access to public conveniences and accommodations and acquisition through purchase of rental or real property including but not limited to housing, and to eliminate segregation or separation based solely on race, religion, color, familial status, sex, handicap, national origin or ancestry, since such segregation is an impediment to equal opportunity, and Familial Status.

WHEREAS, equal education and employment opportunities and equal access to and use of public accommodations and equal opportunity for acquisition of real property as declared to be civil rights in accordance with the Indiana Civil Rights Law (I.C. 22-9-1),

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana, that it is the public policy of the Town Council of Georgetown to support and encourage equal education and employment opportunities and equal access to and use of public accommodations and equal opportunity for acquisition of real property in accordance with the Indiana Civil Rights Law (IC-22-9-1); and real property in accordance with the Indiana Civil Rights Law (IC-22-9-1); and

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana, designates the Indiana Civil Rights commission as the agency appropriate to implement the purposes and objectives of the Indiana Civil Rights Law and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Town Council of Georgetown.




