ORDINANCE NO. G-96-03

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE THE USE OF THE TOWN HALL PARKING LOT BY CITIZENS OF THE TOWN

WHEREAS, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, has deemed it necessary that the Town develop laws which govern the use of the Town of Georgetown's parking lot located next to the Town Hall by the public at large;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Any person having business with the Town of Georgetown is permitted to park their motor vehicle in the Town of Georgetown's parking lot which is located next to the Town Hall.
- 2. Any person who does not have business with the Town of Georgetown, is not permitted to park their motor vehicle in the Town's parking lot.
- 3. Any motor vehicle which is parked in the Town's parking lot in violation of this ordinance shall be towed at the expense of the owner of said motor vehicle.
