

**TOWN OF GEORGETOWN**

**Ordinance No. G-18-08**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES, OR SECTIONS OF  
ORDINANCES, RELATED TO THE WATER UTILITY**

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Georgetown, Indiana sold its water utility in November 2017.

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Georgetown, Indiana has previously enacted several ordinances, including rates ordinances, related to the operation and management of the water utility.

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Georgetown, Indiana no longer operates and manages the utility and therefore is no longer in need of any ordinances which handle that business.

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is aware of the following water utility ordinances no longer needed: G-70; G-85-04; G-91-10; G-96-05; G-96-06; G-96-07; G-99-02; G-99-03; G-99-09; G-01-10; G-02-05; G-04-32; G-04-41; G-05-22; G-05-31; G-08-16; G-10-12; and G-12-14.

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana wishes to repeal any water related ordinance which is in conflict with the sale of the water utility.

**WHEREAS**, after discussion, review and further consideration, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana desires to repeal all ordinances related to the operation and management of the water utility within the Town.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE  
TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**BE IT ORDAINED** that the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana repeals any and all ordinances no longer needed which relate to the operation and management of the water utility, including rate ordinances. Said ordinances shall include: G-70; G-85-04; G-91-10; G-96-05; G-96-06; G-96-07; G-99-02; G-99-03; G-99-09; G-01-10; G-02-05; G-04-32; G-04-41; G-05-22; G-05-31; G-08-16; G-10-12; and G-12-14. Further, The Town Council for the Town of Georgetown, Indiana further repeals any other water related ordinance which is in conflict with the sale of the water utility.

**Severability:** If any article, chapter, clause, provision, portion of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect any other article, chapter, clause, provision or portion of this Ordinance.
