Ordinance G-09-08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE GEORGETOWN MUNICIPAL WORKS BOARD TO PROVIDE INTERNET PROTOCOL ENABLED SERVICES INCLUDING BROADBAND SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana (hereinafter this “Town Council”), is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown, County of Floyd, State of Indiana (the “Town”); and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council, after all proper consideration and review, has determined that the Town Council shall be the controlling body for any and all public utilities and for such purposes shall be known as the Georgetown Municipal Works Board; and

WHEREAS, the Georgetown Municipal Works Board desires to offer Internet Protocol enabled services including Broadband services to its customers and potential customers; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for these services in the Georgetown, Indiana and in Floyd County, Indiana and in Harrison County, Indiana and the Georgetown Municipal Works Board has the financial, managerial, and technical capability to provide such services; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Town, the Georgetown Municipal Works Board, and their customers for the Georgetown Municipal Works Board to have the authority to provide Internet Protocol enabled services including Broadband services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THIS TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Georgetown Municipal Works Board, for and on behalf of the Town, is hereby authorized to make capital improvements, acquire equipment and facilities necessary to provide Internet Protocol enabled services including Broadband services to customers interested in receiving such service.


Section 2. The Georgetown Municipal Works Board is authorized to engage consultants and legal counsel and to take any and all actions necessary to provide Internet Protocol enabled services including Broadband services in Georgetown, Indiana and anywhere within Floyd County, Indiana and Harrison County, Indiana or elsewhere permitted by law.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption and signatures by the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict shall remain in full force and effect.
