An Ordinance Ratifying Amendments to Floyd County Ordinance No. 1997-FCO-XI

Ordinance # G-10- 06

WHEREAS, under I.C. 16-20-1-23 the Floyd County Health Department may order what is reasonable and necessary for prevention and suppression of disease and in all reasonable ways protect the public health;

WHEREAS, the Floyd County Health Department is the health department for the town of Georgetown, Indiana, and has jurisdiction over the territorial limits of Georgetown, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners for Floyd County, Indiana, has amended Article VI, Section 2(a) of Ordinance 1997-FCO-XI to read :

"ARTICLE VI. RESIDENTIAL PERMITS

SECTION 2. Construction Permits for residential sewage disposal systems shall be issued by the Health Officer only upon a determination that the proposed system, or the alteration, repair of, or addition to an existing system, complies with the requirements, terms, and provisions of Residential Rule 410, this Ordinance, and the following:

a. The terms and provisions of Residential Rule 410 and Indiana State Department of Health Bulletin S.E. 11 to the contrary, notwithstanding, permits for the construction or installation of permanent privies, to include sanitary vault privies *and compost toilets*, shall not be issued."

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Georgetown Town Council that the Amendment of Floyd County Ordinance No. 1997-FCO-XI is hereby ratified by the Town of Georgetown and shall apply within the Town of Georgetown under the jurisdiction of the Floyd County Health Department.
