Ordinance # G-10-13

STAGGERED ELECTED OFFICIAL TERM ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, Georgetown Town Council ("Town Council") desires, pursuant to IND. CODE 36-10-7, to established staggered election terms for elected officials to facilitate continuity in the governance of town matters.

WHEREAS, Georgetown's next municipal election is to be held in the year 2011.

WHEREAS, Georgetown has a population of less than three thousand five hundred (3,500) and is not located within a consolidated city. (Prison inmates have not been counted in determining population size for purposes of this ordinance).

WHEREAS, the Town Council desires to provide for desires to stagger terms for its elected officials as provided under IND.CODE 36-10-7-2.9(b) so that certain elected officials shall serve a term of only three (3) years upon the 2011 municipal election, with succeeding terms for such officials being determined by elections to be held with the general election.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:

1. That the following Town Council positions shall be subject to a three (3) year term upon election in the next municipal election to be held in 2011:
 - a. At Large
 - b. At Large
2. That the Georgetown Clerk-Treasurer shall be subject to a three (3) year term upon election in the next municipal election to be held in 2011.
