BUILDING COMMISSIONER

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN,
INDIANA THAT:

WHEREAS, the Town Council ("Council") desires to organize Town government in a manner that would be more efficient and responsible to the Town citizens.

WHEREAS, the Town has grown in population significantly since the office of Building Commission was established and now requires a dedicated Building Commissioner.

WHEREAS, the Council desires to have a Building Commissioner that would be answerable to the elected body of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED:


1. That Ordinance G-98-14 is repealed to the extent that it names the Clerk-Treasurer, and his/her staff as Building Commissioner.
2. That the Town Council shall appoint from time to time a Building Commissioner, with reasonable compensation for such services.
3. The Building Commissioner shall report to the Town Council President
4. This ordinance goes into effect December 1, 2010.
