Ordinance G-10-21

AN ORDINANCE LOANING MONEY FROM THE WATER CONSTRUCTION FUND TO THE MS4 STORMWATER FUND IN AND FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-8-4, the proper officials of a political subdivision may transfer money, for a prescribed period, from one fund to another fund in need of money for cash flow purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana are the proper officers of the Town of Georgetown, a political subdivision, to transfer money from one fund to another fund for cash flow purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown's MS4 Stormwater Fund is at a loss of cash flow; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown's MS4 Stormwater Fund has the obligation to continue to provide stormwater services to our citizens for which it has a need of cash funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council, after review and consideration, has determined that an ordinance should be adopted transferring money from the Water Construction Fund to the MS4 Stormwater Fund.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. The sum of seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000.00) shall be transferred from the Water Construction Fund to the MS4 Stormwater Fund.





SECTION 2. Said transfer shall be for a limited time only, this seventy-five thousand dollars, shall be repaid to the Water Construction Fund on or before November 8, 2015.

SECTION 3. Should any portion of this ordinance be found to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts of this ordinance shall be severable and shall continue in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED

That all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict shall remain in full force and effect.
