

ORDINANCE NO. G-00-11

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE WAGES OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA. INCLUDING THE GEORGETOWN WATER AND SEWER UTILITIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN THAT:

WHEREAS, the Council for the Town of Georgetown is the entity responsible for fixing of compensation for the employees of the Town Georgetown including the Georgetown Water and Sewer Utilities:

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion, it was agreed that the below-named Town employee classifications are entitled to and shall receive the compensation set forth herein..

Superintendent	\$12.14 per hour
Certified Water Opr/Laborer	\$12.00 per hour
Class 1 Laborer (2 position only)	\$10.50 per hour
Class 2 Laborer (2 position only)	\$9.50 per hour
Class 3 Laborer (1 position only)	\$8.50 per hour

Definitions

- Superintendent - Employee to oversee, direct and supervise all Class laborers and Certified Water Operator/Laborer. Knowledgeable in all aspects of water/sewer systems with an active CDL license.
- Certified Wtr Opr/Laborer - An employee with a current Water Certification and knowledgeable of all IDEM requirements for a water distribution system.
- Class 1 Laborer - An employee with an active CDL license and a minimum of 60 calendar days of service.
- Class 2 Laborer - An employee with a minimum of 60 calendar days of service.
- Class 3 Laborer - An employee with less than 60 calendar days of service.

At anytime the superintendent is absent on any given full day the employee who is serving as acting superintendent shall earn \$12.14 per hour in lieu of that employee's regular wages.

Any employee working on Saturday or Sunday for the purpose of reading the sewer flow meters and water main meters shall work a minimum of 3 hours at a rate of 1 and ½ their normal hourly wages.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinances not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

The Ordinance shall be effective January 1, 2001.
