ORDINANCE NO. G-02-16

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTING A TEMPORARY BAN ON NEW CONNECTIONS TO THE WATER SYSTEM OPERATED BY THE GEORGETOWN MUNICIPAL WATER UTILITY

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the owner and operator of the Georgetown Municipal Water Utility; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown has supervisory powers over the utilities under its control pursuant to Indiana Code 8-1.5-3-4; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown may adopt rules for the safe, economical, and efficient management and protection of the Georgetown Municipal Water Utility pursuant to Indiana Code 8-1.5-3-4; and

WHEREAS, certain residents of the Town of Georgetown have reported difficulties with water pressure to the Town Council; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has been advised by Ken Brown of the Indiana Department of Environmental Management that a ban should be instituted on all new connection to the water system of the Georgetown Municipal Water Utility until such time as the Town's Waterworks Improvement Project may be completed.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that a ban is hereby instituted on all new connections to the water system of the Georgetown Municipal Water Utility until such time as the Town's Waterworks Improvement Project may be completed. This ordinance shall automatically terminate upon completion of the Waterworks

Improvement Project or one year from the date upon which it is adopted by the Town

Council of the Town of Georgetown, whichever occurs first.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any portion of any
Ordinance of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, that is in conflict with this Ordinance is
hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinances not in conflict with
this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
