

ORDINANCE NO. G-03- 04

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF SKATEBOARDS
ON PROPERTY OWNED BY THE TOWN OF
GEORGETOWN, INDIANA**

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown is authorized to pass ordinances for the protection of the safety of the public under I.C. 36-8-2-4; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown is authorized to pass ordinances regulating the use of public streets and sidewalks under I.C. 36-9-2-7; and

WHEREAS, public property in the Town Georgetown has been damaged and/or destroyed by individuals using skateboards; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown has determined that, in the interest of protecting the safety of the public, that the use of skateboards should be prohibited on all public property in the Town of Georgetown.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that the use of skateboards is prohibited on all public property owned by Town of Georgetown, Indiana; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for each instance in which the person is found to be in violation of this Ordinance;


NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any person found to have damaged or destroyed property of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana while in violation of this Ordinance shall be liable to the Town for the actual amount of damages suffered by the Town of Georgetown in addition to any fine imposed;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that if any minor child is found to have damaged or destroyed property of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana while in violation of this ordinance, the parents of said minor child shall be liable for the fine imposed on the child as well as any actual damages to Town property pursuant to I.C. 34-31-4-1 and I.C. 34-31-4-2;


