ORDINANCE NO. G-03- 13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. G-02-02 AND ORDINANCE NO. G-02-21 PROVIDING FOR THE WAGES OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA INCLUDING THE GEORGETOWN WATER AND SEWER UTILITIES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA THAT

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-5-3-2, the Town Council for the Town of Georgetown is the entity responsible for fixing the compensation of the employees of the Town of Georgetown, including the Georgetown Water and Sewer Utilities;

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown has determined that the Town is in need of a part-time temporary file clerk;

WHEREAS, after further consideration and discussion, it was agreed that said part-time file clerk should receive compensation for said services at the rate of \$9.00 per hour;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that a part-time temporary file clerk shall be hired to meet the Town's immediate need for such services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the part-time temporary file clerk hired by the Town of Georgetown shall receive compensation for said services at the rate of \$9.00 per hour;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the part-time temporary file clerk shall not work more than 30 hours in any single workweek;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the part-time temporary file clerk shall be employed for a fixed term only, and that said term shall end at 12:00 a.m. on January 1, 2004, at which time the part-time temporary file clerk's employment with the Town of Georgetown shall terminate automatically;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any term or provision of this Ordinance be declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any provision of any
Ordinance of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana that is in conflict with any provision this
Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any provision of any Ordinance
not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
