

**ORDINANCE NO. G-04-02**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS**

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-5-4-2, town monies may be disbursed only after an appropriation made by ordinance of the town legislative body; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council is the legislative body of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-5-3-5, the town legislative body may make further or additional appropriations by ordinance, unless the result would be to increase the tax levy set under I.C. 6-1.1-17; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown has determined that the following additional appropriations should be made from the Gaming Revenue Fund for the 2004 budget year:

1. Personal services: \$35,000.00
2. Other services and charges: \$30,000.00
3. Capital outlays: ~~\$~~5,000.00; and

WHEREAS, said additional appropriations will not increase the tax levy established under I.C. 6-1.1-17.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, that the following additional appropriations shall be made from the Gaming Revenue Fund for the 2004 budget year:


1. Personal services: \$35,000.00
2. Other services and charges: \$30,000.00
3. Capital outlays: ~~\$~~5,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any term or provision of this Ordinance be declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any provision of any Ordinance of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana that is in conflict with any provision this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any provision of any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
