

**ORDINANCE NO. G-04-03**

**AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE HIRING  
OF A TOWN MANAGER FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN**

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-5-3-2, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the entity responsible for establishing the compensation of the officers and employees of the Town of Georgetown; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-5-5-2, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, is authorized to employ a Town Manager and fix his compensation; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown has determined that a Town Manager should be hired for the Town of Georgetown; and

WHEREAS, the funds necessary to provide for the salary of a Town Manager have been appropriated by ordinance by the Town Council.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED that a Town Manager shall be hired for the Town of Georgetown; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Town Manager for the Town of Georgetown shall receive the following compensation:


1. The Town Manager shall receive an annual salary of \$30,000.00.
2. The Town Manager shall receive unlimited local use of a Town vehicle.
3. The Town Manager shall serve at the pleasure of the Town Council. The Town Manager shall be subject to a ninety (90) day probationary period during which his employment may be terminated for any reason or no reason whatsoever. The Town Council shall set a review date following the ninety (90) day probationary period to review the status of the Town Manager's employment.
4. The effective date for the employment of the Town Manager shall be February 1, 2004.
5. The foregoing compensation is based upon the assumption that the Town Manager shall waive any and all health insurance benefits to which he may be entitled as an employee of the Town of Georgetown.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any term or provision of this Ordinance be declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any provision of any Ordinance of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana that is in conflict with any provision this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any provision of any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


