AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE #G-94-25, TO DEFINE "RUBBISH"

WHEREAS, Ordinance #G-94-25 was written to control and enforce the disposal of trash and inoperable/cars within the Town of Georgetown; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown has experienced good success utilizing Ordinance #G-94-25 to clean-up the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown wants to establish maintain a high standard of living for its citizens, to include cleanliness of the Town.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA:

SECTION 1. Amending Section 3 of Ordinance #G-94-25 to add a sub-paragraph a)

a) Rubbish is defined as combustible refuse, including but not limited to: paper, cartons, boxes, barrels, wood, excelsior, tree branches, yard trimmings, leaves (to the extent that said leaves pose a fire hazard and/or pose a threat to public health and safety), wood furniture, other wood or combustible articles, bedding, plastic; and noncombustible refuse including but not limited to: metals, tin cans, contents of litter receptacles, and broken pieces of concrete, asphalt, glass, crockery, bottles and other containers.

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
