

ORDINANCE NO. G-04- 11

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. G-03-18,
AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE WAGES OF
THE EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN**

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 36-5-3-2, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana is the entity responsible for establishing the compensation of the officers and employees of the Town of Georgetown; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown passed Ordinance No. G-03-18, AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE WAGES OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, in a public meeting on December 16, 2003; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown has determined that certain amendments should be made to Ordinance No. G-03-18 with respect to the Town's utility employees; and

WHEREAS, after thoughtful consideration and discussion, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown has decided that the position of "Sewer Supervisor" should be created; and

WHEREAS, after due consideration and discussion, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown has determined that the Town's Sewer Supervisor should be compensated at the rate of \$14.50 per hour.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the position of "Sewer Supervisor" is hereby created for the Town of Georgetown; and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that effective May 5, 2004, the Sewer Supervisor for the Town of Georgetown shall be compensated at the rate of \$14.50 per hour; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that should any term or provision of this Ordinance be declared to be unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the remainder of this Ordinance which shall remain in full force and effect; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that any provision of any Ordinance of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana that is in conflict with any provision this Ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any provision of any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.




