

AN ORDINANCE OF THE Town of  
Georgetown  
AMENDING ORDINANCE No. G-04-07  
PROVIDING FOR EMPLOYEE  
PAYROLL RULES FOR THE Town of  
Georgetown

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana, wants to provide for equitable pay of its employees while maintaining the best interests of the Town; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council identifies that Employees have control over when they take vacation, sick leave and personal time, but no control over when Holidays fall.


Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana that:


Section 1: The following paragraph of Ordinance No. G-04-07 is amended as indicated below, striking the word "Holidays" from the ordinance. This paragraph is the first whole paragraph at the top of the second page in Ordinance No. G-04-07.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the employees of the Town of Georgetown and the employees of the Georgetown Water and Sewer Utilities, excluding the Officers, shall be paid overtime rate for all hours worked over 40 hours per week. No vacation days, sick leave, personal leave, or funeral leave ~~or holidays~~ shall be counted toward hours worked, nor included in calculating whether an employee is entitled to overtime compensation.

Section 2: The remainder of Ordinance No. G-04-07 is reiterated and continues to be in full force and effect.
