Ordinance # G-04-35

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NEW POLICY FOR THE MANAGEMENT OF THE WATER DEVELOPMENT FUNDS, AKA WATER TAP FEES FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, IN

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown is the entity responsible for managing the Town's money, including monies paid into the Town's water works, under the provisions of IC 36-9-23; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown desires to place the money paid for water development, i.e. Tap Fees, into a special account for accounting and reporting purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED the Town's Clerk/Treasurer is hereby directed to place any and all monies received by the Town as water development fees, AKA Tap Fees, into the Town's Water Utility Construction Fund, #602.


SEVERABILITY


Should any portion of this ordinance be found to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts of this ordinance shall be severable and shall continue in full force and effect.


This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption by the Town Council.
