Ordinance # G-06- 15

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §8.6 AND §8.7 OF
THE GEORGETOWN ZONING ORDINANCE,
REQUIRING INSTALLATION OF TRACING
WIRE/TAPE ON ALL WATER AND SEWER
MAINS INSTALLED IN AND FOR THE
TOWN OF GEORGETOWN**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN,
INDIANA THAT:

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown has reviewed the Zoning Ordinance and particularly the Water and Sewer Utilities Construction Requirements therein; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown has identified the desirability of specifying and requiring the use of tracing wire/tape on all newly constructed water and sewer mains within the Town by specifically stating this design requirements; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown wants to insure that these water and sewer mains can be located from above the ground after they are buried underground in order to provide for the general welfare of our citizens by allowing water and/or sewer repairs and other utility main problems to be found and addressed in a timely manner.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. Section 8.6 Water Facilities, paragraph A. General Requirements, subparagraph 2. of the Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read:

2. Where a public water main is accessible the subdivider shall install adequate water facilities (including fire hydrants) conforming to the requirements and specifications of the State or local authorities. All water mains shall be at least six (6) inches in diameter and shall be laid with tracing wire or tape affixed to the new water pipes.

SECTION 2. Section 8.7 Sewerage Facilities, paragraph B. of the Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to read:


- B. Sanitary Sewerage System Requirements. Where provided, sanitary sewerage facilities shall connect with public sanitary sewerage systems, and shall be installed to serve each lot to grades and sizes required by approving officials and agencies. Sanitary

sewerage facilities (including the installation of laterals in the right-of-way) shall be subject to the specifications, rules, regulations, and guidelines of the Health Officer, participating jurisdiction, and appropriate State agency. All Sewer mains shall be laid with tracing wire or tape affixed to the new water pipes.

SECTION 3. The remainder of Section 8 of the Zoning Ordinance is confirmed and reiterated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


