Ordinance # G-06- 29

### AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE UNSAFE BUILDING FUND IN AND FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN.

# BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code Section 36 et seq., the proper officials of a political subdivision may establish such financial accounting funds necessary to properly maintain and monitor public monies; and,

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana are the proper officers of the Town of Georgetown, a political subdivision, to establish such funds for accounting purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown has enacted the State's Unsafe Building Code, and this legislation requires the existence of an Unsafe Building Fund, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council, after review and consideration, has determined that an ordinance should be adopted formally establishing the Unsafe Building Fund.

#### NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

**SECTION 1.** \$5,000 from the Town of Georgetown's Gaming Fund, #242, shall be transferred and moved into the new Unsafe Building Fund. This initial deposit may never be utilized, as the Unsafe Building Fund is designed to be self-supporting, but this \$5,000 is "seed" money to make the Fund operational and solvent.

**SECTION 2.** The Unsafe Building Fund shall used by the Town's Building Department to assist in ridding the Town of unsafe building structures.

### SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

Should any portion of this ordinance be found to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts of this ordinance shall be severable and shall continue in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect,
