

**TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, IN**  
**Ordinance No. G-06-32**

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER  
G-06-20 AS PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE TOWN  
COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA**

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana previously adopted Ordinance number G-06-20 annexing two tracts of real estate associated with the O'Brien Farm property, both of which are located in the unincorporated territory of Floyd County, Indiana, into the corporate boundaries of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana, pursuant to the provisions of IC 36-4-3-5.1; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council, with the assistance of its Counsel, has identified there are some technical flaws with this annexation ordinance; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council has determined that these flaws make this annexation untenable in its current status.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE **GEORGETOWN TOWN COUNCIL**

**Section 1.**


Georgetown Ordinance number G-06-20 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption by the Town Council.




