## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE G-05-23 CREATING A BROADBAND UTILITY TECHNICIAN EMPLOYEE POSITION FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA:

WHEREAS, the Town Council has created a Broadband Utility Fund from which to operate the new Broadband Utility Enterprise; and,

**WHEREAS**, the creation of this new utility will require additional manpower to operate the utility; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown already has an established practice of having at least one man as an expert in each of the utility services we provide to the Town and then relying on extensive cross-training and teamwork to properly and efficiently deliver that utility to our citizens; and,

WHEREAS, the contract has been signed with the highspeed internet vendor and the equipment has been ordered to bring mygwhiz.org into reality on or before February 1, 2007.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

**SECTION 1**. Section 4 of Ordinance G-05-23 is hereby amended to allow for an additional Utility Technician position as the Town's expert on Broadband. This new Broadband Utility Technician will be paid at the same rate/wage as the existing Utility Technician position, in accordance with the overall structure of the Omnibus Merit Wage Increase Ordinance (G-05-23). This will provide for a Sewer Utility Technician and a Broadband Utility Technician in total at this time. This means the Town Manager will promote existing Laborer Grant Wilson to the Broadband Technician position, and that will leave a Laborer position open that needs to be filled, in order to provide enough manpower to provide the new Broadband Utility while continuing to provide our existing utilities of: sanitary sewer, drinking water, streets, drainage/stormwater sewer and garbage collections.

## **SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY**

Should any portion of this ordinance be found to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts of this ordinance shall be severable and shall continue in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby

repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
