Ordinance # G-07- 1)

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CLERK-TREASURER TO BE ALLOWED TO MAKE INITIAL PAYMENT, DEPOSIT AND INSTALLATION FEE REFUNDS TO WOULD-BE BROADBAND CUSTOMERS WHOSE LOCATIONS WE CANNOT REACH DUE TO REDUCED ACTUAL SIGNAL RANGE FROM INITIALLY BELIEVED SIGNAL RANGE FOR THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, IN

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of Georgetown is the entity responsible for managing the Town's money, including monies paid into the Town's Broadband Utility, under the provisions of IC 36-9-23; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of Georgetown desires to refund monies paid by potential Broadband Customers who are located outside the actual range of our system as currently configured, and will be outside of our range for the foreseeable future.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED the Town's Clerk/Treasurer is hereby authorized to refund any monies which have been received by the Town as Broadband install, initial monthly and deposit fees, from the Town's Broadband Utility Fund, #140, returning said monies back to the would-have-been Broadband Customer, if it has been determined that our current signal output cannot reach their location. This authorization precludes the need to wait for a Docket Listing on these refunds.

## **SEVERABILITY**

Should any portion of this ordinance be found to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts of this ordinance shall be severable and shall continue in full force and effect.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon adoption by the Town Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
