Ordinance # G-07- 18

**AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE
#G-07-16 TO GIFT MONEY FROM THE
CUMULATIVE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND
TO THE GENERAL FUND INSTEAD OF LOANING
THE MONEY**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA THAT:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code 36-1-8-4, the proper officials of a political subdivision may transfer money, for a prescribed period, from one fund to another fund in need of money for cash flow purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the members of the Town Council of Georgetown, Indiana are the proper officers of the Town of Georgetown, a political subdivision, to transfer money from one fund to another fund for cash flow purposes; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown's General Fund is experiencing a reduced cash flow because the Town will not realize approximately \$100,000 in mid-year property tax receipts until approximately July, and;

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown's General Fund has the obligation to continue to provide General Government services to our citizens including but not limited to: police protection, Town Council and Town Clerk activities, & building inspections, for which it has a weekly need of cash funds, and;

WHEREAS, the Town Council, after review and consideration, has determined that an ordinance should be adopted giving money from CCI Fund #401, , to General Fund #101.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. Ordinance #07-16 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. The sum of eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000) shall be transferred from the CCI Fund to the General Fund.

SECTION 3. Said transfer is a gift from the Cumulative Capital Improvement Fund #401 to the General Fund #101, Account Line Item #101.001.4940.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY

Should any portion of this ordinance be found to be invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts of this ordinance shall be severable and shall continue in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
