Ordinance # G-07- 33

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING §110 OF THE
GEORGETOWN CODE OF ORDINANCES,
CLARIFYING THE REQUIREMENT FOR BUSINESSES
TO BE LICENSED IN THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GEORGETOWN,
INDIANA THAT:

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown has reviewed Section 110 of the Town's Code of Ordinances; and,

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Georgetown has identified that the parameters set forth by §110 are proper but do not allow for the new business/commercial areas that exist in Town, plus any that may be brought into the Town's corporate boundaries by annexation; and,

WHEREAS, the Georgetown Town Council is most interested in adopting and enforcing rules and regulations that are equitable to all of our citizens, including our business or corporate citizens.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. Section 110, **Permits Required of Businesses**, of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read:

(A) Any permitted business and/or commercial establishments operating within the ~~Town Commercial Convenience District or the Commercial General District, as set forth in the town's comprehensive plan~~, must obtain a business permit from the Town Hall at the cost of \$25.

(B) All business permits shall be renewed annually by the business and/or commercial establishment at the same cost and shall be between January 1 and January 15 of every year thereafter.

SECTION 2. The remainder of Section 110 of the Code of Ordinances is confirmed and reiterated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
