Ordinance # G-08- 05

**AN ORDINANCE FORMALLY REAFFIRMING PREVIOUS
ORDINANCES PROVIDING FOR THE CONTROL OF
THE TOWN'S PUBLIC UTILITIES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE
TOWN OF GEORGETOWN, INDIANA THAT:

WHEREAS, the Town of Georgetown (hereinafter "Georgetown") has adopted an ordinance (#G-06-21) providing for the control of any or all of its municipally owned utilities by a board consisting of the members of the Georgetown Town Council (hereinafter "Council") as allowed by IC 8-1.5-3-3; and,

WHEREAS, the Council, after all proper consideration and review, has determined that the Council shall continue as the controlling body for any or all public utilities, including but not limited to sewer works and treatment plant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

1. That Georgetown Town Ordinance #G-06-21 be reaffirmed.
2. That the Council shall continue to serve as the governing body for any or all municipal utilities. And for such purposes shall be known as the Georgetown Municipal Works Board; Utility Service Board; or, Waste Management Board; for the control of the Town's utilities including the contemplation of IC 36-9-23.
3. That the currently serving members on the Council and Waste Management Board, collectively the "Municipal Works Board" are:
 - Billy Stewart - President
 - Mike Mills - Vice President
 - Aaron Striegel
 - Everett Pullen
 - Karla Perkins
4. Should any portion of this ordinance be found invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining parts of this ordinance shall be severable and shall continue in full force and effect.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all Ordinances of the Town of Georgetown, Indiana which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and any Ordinance not in conflict with this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
